

# Encountering Christmas Mary

Luke 1:26-38

## MAIN IDEAS

- Mary takes God at His word
- Mary's joyful submission
  - In humility
  - When it's not easy
- Other examples of submission

Read Luke 1:26-38. In what ways was this good news for Mary?

In what ways was this news difficult for her? See Matthew 1:18-19.

Read Esther 3:13, 4:8-14 and Daniel 3:1-15. Put yourself in Esther's shoes, and then in Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego's shoes. What would your attitude be?

What are Mary's attitudes in Luke 1:38,46-55? What is Esther's attitude in Esther 4:15-16? What is Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego's attitude in Daniel 3:16-18?

Why do you think they're able to have these attitudes?

What do we need in order to experience joy, according to Psalm 13:5, Psalm 33:21, and 1 Peter 1:8?

What does it take to submit joyfully in tough situations?

Read Matthew 1:20-25, Esther 5:1-3, Daniel 3:19-30. How did God intervene for Mary, Esther, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego?

#### PERSONAL RESPONSE

Is submission to God hard for you? What could make it easier?

How has God intervened on your behalf?
