Add some variety to your prayer life this week:

- Do you lack scheduled prayer time? Set aside some regular time for prayer.
- Do you tend to only pray at scheduled times? Try praying spontaneously throughout the day.
- Consider where you normally pray. Go to one or more new places to pray.
- Pray about things you don't usually pray about.
- Be mindful of the moving of the Holy Spirit. Pray for people and situations as the Lord brings them to your mind.

REPRODUCE

Who do you pray with? Or do you only pray alone?

Ask someone to pray with you this week, or join a group to pray with: friends, family, small group, leaders, etc.

Ask someone to help keep you accountable in your prayer life.
